

# Assembly Instructions

351 Hepburn Bed

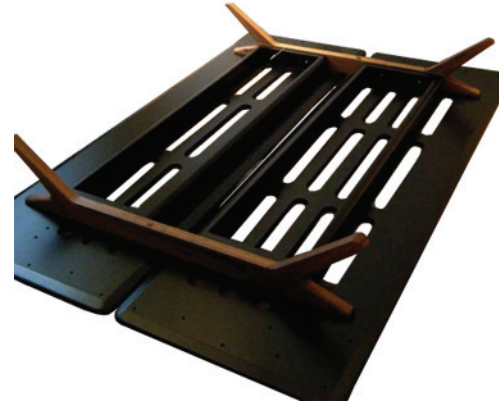

1) Unpack components and lay them out so they are in the correct orientation. Check for number markings on platforms and leg bases.



2) Determine the headboard end of platforms by locating holes where the headboard connects. Make sure the headboard is orientated in desired direction. Determine the outer edge of the bed by locating the small screw hole shown in Figure 7 below.



3) Place platforms 1 and 2 side by side so the number markings are facing up. Insert wooden dowels on leg frames to the corresponding holes in the platform (1 matches to 1, etc). The legs will sit across the two panels. Slot silver bolts in place and tighten



4) Ensure the silver bolts are firmly tightened. Use a 6mm Allen key for tightening. Connect both leg frames to both platforms using the aforementioned method.



5) Once both leg frames are attached firmly to the platform, flip the bed over into its natural position with the help of a friend.



6) Attach the headboard. Determine the correct orientation by ensuring the flattest face is pointing toward the wall behind. Slot black bolts into the provided holes and tighten up using a 5mm Allen key. Be sure to tighten firmly.



7) Once bed is fully assembled, attach side tables if applicable. Slot black bolts into the provided holes and tighten up using a 5mm Allen key. Be sure to tighten firmly.



8) The bed assembly is now complete and the bed is ready to receive the mattress. Place the mattress over the platform so that it is centred and the platform is completely covered.

## Notes

### Parts:

- 1 headboard
- 2 platforms
- 2 leg bases
- 8 black bolts per side table (if relevant)
- 8 - 10 black bolts for headboard depending on bed size
- 8 silver bolts

### You will need:

- 5mm heavy duty Allen Key
- 6mm heavy duty Allen Key

### Instructions:

NOTE 1 - Be certain that all assembly is carried out on a flat and stable surface. This will ensure a good final result. Reverse the steps to disassemble the piece.

NOTE 2 - Your furniture arrives packed in numerous layers that protect it during transport. It is important that you remove the packaging carefully to avoid damaging your furniture. Refer to our information sheet "Unpacking Your Furniture" for further details.

NOTE 3 - Great care is required when assembling Oak / Walnut products, they can mark very easily if banged or dropped; De La Espada furniture is hand made and no one part is replaceable - if one piece is damaged and has to be replaced, this means the entire unit will require replacement. Use blankets to soften the assembly surface - hard surfaces such as wood or stone flooring may damage the furniture if in direct contact.

NOTE 4 - We advise that disassembly and assembly of De La Espada furniture is undertaken by a minimum of 2 people.

NOTE 5 - All mating parts are numbered so they correspond to the appropriate part around the frame of the bed. You will ensure the best possible fit if all parts are mated with the corresponding numbered parts.
